

## Application Check List

- Attend Student/Parent Zoom information session
- Visit Early College Website:

- Confirm with counselor you meet the 2.2 GPA and above
- Applicant's school attendance has been a priority
- Applicant is on track with credits and meeting Michigan Merit Curriculum requirements
- Confirm with Counselor you would like to proceed with Accuplacer Testing
- Accuplacer score is commonly used as an entrance exam for community college. Testing will start in November and end in January
- Use following websites to prepare:

- Must pass the Reading/Writing portions of the Accuplacer. Two attempts will be given
- Once Accuplacer is passed, student will receive official application folder outlining the next steps
- Applicant collects required information and brings folder to Application Days in February
- Application process ends with an Interview of candidate with panel that consists of county counselors, Principals, Lake Michigan College Administration, and Superintendents
- Applicants will be notified of acceptance in April
